Why do Muslim immigrant women in Berlin feel integrated, but not accepted by the German society?

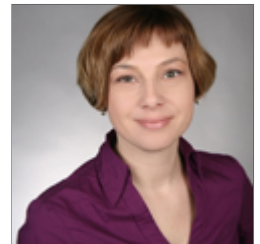
